<u>Create your own Brazilian</u> <u>Merganser</u>

Paper Craft

Materials & Instructions

*This craft requires scissors. Adult supervision should be present if this craft is being done by children. *

Materials:

- Printout sheet with Brazilian Merganser body parts
- Construction paper/colored paper/feathers (for head crest)
- Glue
- Scissors
- Blank paper or construction paper (to assemble pieces)
- * Optional* Crayons/markers/colored pencils
- *Optional* Googly eyes

Instructions:

- Cut out each piece with scissors along the outer black lines
- Place glue on the back side of your cut pieces
- Assemble each cut piece on a sheet of paper to assemble your bird
- *Recommended order of piece placement*
 - Body
 - Tail
 - Head
 - Eye
 - Beak
 - Wing
 - Feet
- Once each piece is glued and assembled on your paper, make a crest! Use cut construction paper, cut colored paper, feathers, or any other creative materials you can think of! The limit is your imagination!
- Glue your crest on your bird
- Congratulations! You have made your very own Brazilian Merganser!


Optional variations for more creativity:

- Instead of using the pre-colored version of this craft, use the uncolored version to give your bird a unique color palette! The colors provided are based on the real bird, but your bird can be as unique as you!
- Instead of using the provided "Eye" piece, give your bird more personality with a googly eye instead!
- Draw a background for your bird! Maybe your bird is swimming, has a nest, or is standing on a rock. Turn that blank background into a masterpiece!

Optional cutout methods for younger children

- If scissors are not to be used by children, adults who are preparing this craft can pre-cut the pieces. Children can then skip to the coloring and gluing steps of the process.
- Adults can also use the pieces as stencils to trace the pieces on matching colored construction paper, then pre-cut the construction paper pieces for children
